## **Crop Insurance for Growers**

COVERED PERILS: Adverse Weather Conditions, Fire, Uncontrollable Insects & Disease (where there is no

effective control), Wildlife, Failure of Irrigation Water Supply (due to a covered loss)

UNIT STRUCTURE: Optional Units, Basic Units

COVERAGE: These are used for calculating an indemnity payment:

Stage 1: Planting - tasseling 65% of liability
Stage 2: Tasseling - harvest 100% of liability

REPLANT PAYMENT: Buy-up policies only

PLANTING PERIODS BY COUNTY

Broward, Miami, & Palm Beach (Winter, Fall & Spring) Glades, Hendry & Martin (Fall & Spring only)

Fall: 7/15 through 10/15 Spring: 1/16 through 3/15 Winter: 10/16 through 1/15

DeSoto & Indian River Fall: 8/1 through 8/31 Spring: 2/1 through 4/15

Lake & Orange Fall: 8/1 through 8/31 Spring: 2/25 through 4/30

Suwannee Fall: 7/15 through 8/31 Spring: 2/25 through 5/15

GA (all counties) Fall: 7/15 through 8/25 Spring: 3/1 through 5/15

AL (Baldwin)

Spring: 3/15 through 5/15

### Loss Example

Sample Data - Palm Beach County

- 100 acres of final stage sweet corn (Fall planted)
- Elected 75% coverage level
- Insurance coverage per acre \$1,608
- Unit guarantee \$168,800 (\$1,608 x 100 acres)
- Production after loss 100 containers per acre
- Average sale price per container \$9.25
- Allowable cost per 42-pound carton \$4.35
- Net value per container \$4.90

#### Loss Calculation

\$168,800 Amount of insurance\*

- \$49,000 Value of sold production\*\*

\$119,800 Indemnity

\*1,608 x 100 acres = \$160,800 \*\* 100 x \$4.90 x 100 acres = \$49,000

Loss example based on Palm Beach County, FL Cooling cost will not exceed \$1.50 per container if paid by the insured.

Growers can also add the Hurricane Insurance Protection (HIP) endorsement as follows:

# Coverage Options *Hurricane Insurance Protection*

When the HIP Endorsement is added:

- Crop value per acre is \$2,145
- Coverage on underlying policy is 75%, available HIP is 20%
- Elect protection factor between 1-100% in whole numbers
- Elected 100% protection factor = \$429 per acre coverage
- \$42,900 HIP coverage paid in full if triggered by a hurricane in your county or an adjacent county (100 x \$429)
